Dear Mr Deane;

Previous correspondence refers. We acknowledge receipt of a package from you containing 18 documents purporting to be 'statements of fact' in relation to the alleged incidents of September 2nd 2015 in Castlebar Courthouse under which auspices you purport to represent the Office of the DPP and intend it seems, to attempt to criminalise myself and Mr Colm Granahan for simply objecting (as is our lawful right) to the unconstitutional and unlawful conduct of various Officers of the Court – including Judge Kevin Kilraine – on the day in question. We also note the fact that several members of An Garda Síochána present on the day completely and utterly failed in their duty to the people, to the law and to the Constitution, yet you have nevertheless presumed to present statements from those Gardaí as grounds for this spurious prosecution – including a statement from the so-called prosecuting officer, Sgt Naomi De Ris, who was herself already under citizens' arrest for her part in facilitating previous unlawful assaults on the public, and for unlawfully preventing public access to the Courts.

Of the 18 statements you are relying upon to prosecute, we note that 11 are from Gardaí and that the remaining 7 are variously from Courts Service Staff, connected solicitors and other members of the establishment, but that despite multiple references in those statements to various clients and members of the public being present in the Court that day, that you have not produced even one single statement from any of those other persons – despite the alarmist allegations and references to their supposed fear and distress during the events of that day.

Notwithstanding the somewhat ludicrous position you have found yourself in attempting to criminalise law abiding members of the public Mr Deane; and notwithstanding the still-outstanding criminal complaints of conspiracy which we lodged as against DPP Claire Loftus and senior Gardaí which have yet to be properly dealt with; and notwithstanding your own underhanded role in attempting to interfere in our civil case as against George Collins, (2nd cousin to Taoiseach Enda Kenny) in 2011 and your own subsequent acts of professional misconduct and attempted intimidation of my family and myself via the improper use of An Garda Síochána; and notwithstanding any other incidences of unlawful or improper conduct by agents of the State which will no doubt be aired if we are indeed going to be furnished with anything resembling a fair hearing in these matters; I hereby place you personally on notice that if it can be demonstrated that you, or any of the persons submitting statements to the Court are found to be in any way attempting to mislead the Court or are otherwise involved in any of the usual attempts to interfere with, obstruct or pervert the course of justice (which we assert is exactly what is going on here) then you may be assured that you will be privately prosecuted for any such acts; that you will also face civil claims for damages; and that any and

all such actions will be publicised in full. We regret the need to be so emphatic on this point Mr Deane, but as you are already very well aware, this is really the only line of defence we have left against the insidious machinations of a so-called 'justice system' which is demonstrably bereft of consistency, fairness or equality and which is being administered in the main, by persons of questionable moral character whose primary agenda is to protect and promote an endemically corrupt status quo – whatever the cost to justice and truth.

We respectfully suggest Mr Deane that you alert your witnesses to this advisory in advance of the next hearing because once these vexatious proceeding have properly commenced, we will accept no belated excuses or apologies from those whom we assert are clearly engaged in a conspiracy to criminalise myself and Mr Granahan, and are attempting to mislead the Court – as well as the public at large – as to the full facts, and the truth and circumstances of that day.

I further note that amongst those either submitting or witnessing these purported 'statements of fact' are certain persons whom I have had cause to lodge criminal or civil complaints against for some truly outrageous actions, including failing or refusing to respect Court summonses; conspiring with other agencies of the State to concoct false charges against me; and other scandalous acts of omission or commission which, were they to be committed by any ordinary person – or indeed, if our justice system operated in a truly fair and impartial manner – would have resulted in the immediate prosecution and incarceration of those persons for undeniably criminal acts. The details of these will of course be introduced in our submissions in due course.

You might also be advised Mr Deane, that given Judge Devins' inexcusable display of judicial impropriety on June 1st last (which we note is only the latest in a growing list of such incidents) that I have written to President Higgins, the Chief Justice, the Taoiseach, the Minister for Justice, the Garda Commissioner, the Policing Authority, various TD's and the European Court of Human Rights (and certain interested others) alerting them to the situation and advising them – as I am now advising you – that I will not willingly be party to any unlawful, unconstitutional or criminal activity engineered by those in the pay of the State, on the grounds that to do so would be in contravention of my fundamental and Constitutional rights.

On this basis, please be advised that if I do not receive from the Judge a personal guarantee of safety from unlawful assault by persons in the pay of the State, then I will NOT engage with you or others in this preposterous and shabby exercise, other that is absolutely required to defend myself and my family from further criminal abuses – and an advisory to this effect has been lodged with the Court Office for the attention of the Judge. This will be my very first submission to the Court, and if it is not accommodated, then I will not participate further in this farce.

We draw your attention to the caveat in previous correspondence, and trust the position is clear.
